**Day for Life:** This year the Day for Life will focus on all those who are suffering or have survived domestic abuse. Following discussion about violence in the home at the Synod on the Family, Pope Francis wrote, "Unacceptable customs still need to be eliminated. I think particularly of the shameful ill-treatment to which women are sometimes subjected, domestic violence and various forms of enslavement which, rather than a show of masculine power, are craven acts of cowardice. The verbal, physical and sexual violence that women endure in some marriages contradicts the very nature of the conjugal union"
